Board of Equalization Meeting – January 3, 2018

The Gage County Board of Equalization met on January 3, 2018 at 8:32 a.m. with Terry Jurgens, John Hill, Myron Dorn, Gary Lytle, Dennis Byars and Erich Tiemann present, Matt Bauman absent. Patti Milligan, County Assessor, present.

Notice of said meeting was posted at the County Clerk's Office and published prior to the meeting in compliance with State Statutes.

Chairman Dorn announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted at the back of the Board of Supervisors Room.

Chairman Dorn declared the 2017 session formally closed – SINE DIE.

County Clerk Dawn Hill assumed control of the meeting and asked the board if they wish to have the same Chairman and Vice Chairman for both the Board of Equalization and the Board of Supervisors and, if so, to make a motion to wait on electing the Chairman and Vice Chairman for both boards at the Board of Supervisors meeting.

Motion made by Byars, seconded by Tiemann to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as mailed/mailed out. Motion carried 6-0.

No public present for comments and request for future agenda items.

Motion made by Byars, seconded by Tiemann to approve tax correction slips #1 & 2. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion made by Tiemann, seconded by Byars to open public hearing at 8:37 a.m. to approve or disapprove tax exemptions on vehicles owned by qualifying nonprofit organizations of Gage County. Motion carried 6-0.

No public present.

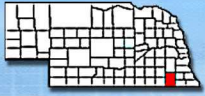
Motion made by Byars, seconded by Tiemann to close public hearing at 8:38 a.m. Motion carried 6-0.
