Board of Supervisors Meeting – September 23, 2020

The Gage County Board of Supervisors met on September 23, 2020, at 8:45 a.m. with Terry Jurgens, John Hill, Erich Tiemann, Eddie Dorn, and Gary Lytle present, Matt Bauman and Dennis Byars absent.

Chairman Tiemann announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted at the back of the Board of Supervisors Room.

Consent Agenda included the following items: 1. General Agenda; 2. Minutes from previous meeting and committee meetings; 3. claims audit in the amount of \$7,016,609.16 which does not include claim #20090118 to Beatrice Lawn Care in the amount of \$775.00, to be voted on separately; 4. approve correspondence received and place on file; 5. Approve receiving treasurer's list of delinquent taxes on parcels of real estate in the County, which remain unsold for want of bidders and directing the County Treasurer to issue county tax sale certificates. 6. Approve verifying sheriff's distress warrant report and striking DW #6907100 in the amount of \$81.21.7. Approve Utility Permit #1160 to Diller Telephone – will be plowing and boring in approximately 2 ¹/₄ miles of fiber 48ct, 24ct or 2ct cable. Will bore 3" diameter, 5-10' deep below creeks, road crossing's and all culverts. Cable will be encased in 1 1/4" smooth wall pipe. Cable will be placed 24' from center of road in the bottom of the grader ditch 5' deep and vaults will be placed along the 33' right-ofway.
