Board of Supervisors Special Budget Meeting – September 7, 2022

The Gage County Board of Supervisors met on September 7, 2022, at 8:00 a.m. with Terry Jurgens, Erich Tiemann, Dave Swavely and Gary Lytle present, Emily Haxby and Eddie Dorn absent.

Notice of said meeting was posted at the County Clerk's Office and published prior to the meeting in compliance with State Statutes.

Let the record show that all proceedings are electronically recorded.

Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Chairman Tiemann announced that a complete copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted at the back of the Board of Supervisors Room.

Motion made by Swavely, seconded by Schuller to open the public hearing at 8:02 a.m. to hear support, opposition or suggestions from taxpayers relating to the proposed FY 22-23 County Budget. Motion carried 5-0.

Dorn present in meeting @ 8:10 a.m.

Chairman Tiemann presented an overview of the budget changes, stated that this was exciting times, the county would be paying off the Beatrice 6 Judgment this fiscal year, that the resolution was passed recently that terminated the sales tax effective January 1, 2023 and the county has a decrease for their tax asking amount. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of Gage County will decrease last year's budget by -4.16 percent. This is very exciting. We have stay relative flat, had continued to maintain the operations of the county and are nearing the end of the judgment. There was no public present at the public hearing, except media. The public hearing was held open for quite some time in the case of someone running late and wanting to speak.

Motion made by Swavely, seconded by Lytle to closed the public hearing at 8:13 a.m. Motion carried 6-0.

RESOLUTION SETTING THE PROPERTY TAX REQUEST **RESOLUTION NO. 22-15**

WHEREAS, Nebraska Revised Statute 77-1632 and 77-1633 provide that the Governing Body of Gage County passes by a majority vote a resolution or ordinance setting the tax request; and

WHEREAS, a special public hearing was held as required by law to hear and consider comments concerning the property tax request;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Governing Body of Gage County resolves that:

1. The 2022-2023 property tax request be set at:
General Fund \$11,770,447.97.
2. The total assessed value of property differs from last year's total assessed value by 6.52 percent.
3. The tax rate which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be 0.366 per \$100 of assessed value.
4. Gage County proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be 0.34163 per \$100 of assessed value.
5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of Gage County will decrease last year's budget

RESOLUTION OF ADOPTION AND APPROPRIATIONS
#22-16

WHEREAS, a proposed County Budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, prepared by the Budget Making Authority, was transmitted to the County Board on the 7th day of September, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Gage County, Nebraska as follows:

SECTION 1. That the budget for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023, as categorically evidenced by the Budget Document be, and the same hereby is, adopted as the Budget for Gage County for said fiscal year.

SECTION 2. That the offices, departments, activities and institutions herein named are hereby authorized to expend the amounts herein appropriated to them during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023.

SECTION 3. That the income necessary to finance the appropriations made and expenditures authorized shall be provided out of the unencumbered cash balance in each fund, revenues other than taxation to be collected during the fiscal year in each fund, and tax levy requirements for each fund.
